

Quaker M.M. Camp 2007

Dear Campers and Prospective Campers,

This year we will be camping in the **Elan Valley**, west of **Rhayader** in mid-Wales. The area is ideal for walking, cycling and visiting places of interest.

**There will be two one-week camps this year: July 21st – July 28th
July 28th – Aug 4th**

Campers may apply for one or two weeks. We strongly encourage people to come for a full week rather than part of a week. Numbers at each camp will be limited to 60. Applications will be dealt with on a first come first served basis and can only be accepted with a deposit. Camps often book up early so please apply in good time. It would help camp organisers if campers notify us of any cancellations immediately. Help with finance and equipment may be available for those who need it. Please contact Karen Williams (see below).

The success of camp depends on everybody contributing what they can. Activities are fairly impromptu, but it helps with planning camp to have an idea of who may be willing to lead an activity or act as a day leader. Please indicate this on the application form. If you have been on camp before and would like to offer help with particular jobs, please write this on your application or let one of the camp planners know.

We try to keep camp fees to a minimum. However, we are trying to build up capital to help replace our cook van when the need arises. Campers who are in a position to make a donation to our Equipment Fund should refer to the form sent out with this letter for more information about how to do this.

Help completing the form:

Charges for camp this year will be the same as last year. For one week's camping:

up to age 4	free
age 5-10	£20
age 11-17	£25
age 18 and over	£ 40 (in age column write A)

The age at camp time applies. If you have a birthday at camp use the lower age, and bring a cake! We also have a formula for those who unavoidably have to miss some days at camp.

If you are a vegetarian please tick the V column. Booking must be accompanied by a non-returnable deposit of £10 per camper (except those under 5 years old). Cheques should be made payable to H & M W M M Camp Fund. All campers will receive confirmation of their booking. Details of how to find the site and what to bring will be sent out in early July.
